The Carriage House is part of the \$2 million renovation plan for the resort which will include a new pool, pool pavilion, parking lot and wedding pavilion.

The renovation included several updates to the Carriage House ballroom, including a new roof, updated interiors, additional windows to better showcase the stunning mountains views, and new doors. The venue also added a commercial kitchen and a large outdoor covered porch with a 3,000-square-foot stone patio featuring a gas fire pit and sweeping views of the White Mountains. Although perhaps best known for storybook weddings, the newly renovated Carriage House is also a popular option for corporate events.
